GOAL #2:

REVIEW HIGHWAY 6 FERGUS BYPASS



Consider what roads could be used as a bypass



Test alternatives in the transportation model



Provide high-level assessment and recommendations for next steps



GOAL #3:

DETERMINE FEASIBILITY OF TRANSIT SERVICES TO CENTRE WELLINGTON



Review existing transit services in comparable and nearby communities





Assess transit needs in Centre Wellington



Estimate transit ridership

Determine feasibility of recommended transit services





GOAL #4:

ASSESS CURRENT & FUTURE PARKING DEMAND IN FERGUS AND ELORA

- Collect and review background information and data collection
- Survey businesses and customers May and August 2017
- 3 Analyze current parking needs
- 4 Analyze future parking needs
- Develop a parking strategy; make recommendations
- Produce a Downtown Parking Strategy Discussion Paper





GOAL #5:

UPDATE TRANSPORTATION POLICIES & SCHEDULES IN THE OFFICIAL PLAN

Recommend additional

- transportation policies that could be incorporated into the Township's Official Plan
- Develop language to updatethe transportation element ofthe Official Plan
- Provide guidance on increasing use of cycling, walking and transit as travel modes





Adopted November 24, 2003 Approved May 31, 2005





GOAL #6:

INTEGRATE RECOMMENDED TRANSPORTATION SOLUTIONS



1 Develop multi-modal implementation strategy



Monitor progress toward goals



Produce the final
Transportation Master Plan
report



GOAL #7:

DEVELOP A TRAFFIC CALMING POLICY MANUAL

- Incorporate complete streets into the discussion
- Identify appropriate traffic calming measures
- Develop framework to review traffic calming requests





GOAL #8:

CONDUCT INCLUSIVE & EFFECTIVE PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT

- 1 Establish a comprehensive consultation & engagement strategy
- Build on existing engagement and communication tools and tactics
- Provide opportunities for engagement at key stages in the process
- Provide a menu of engagement alternatives using a range of tactics
