


Notice of Study Commencement Union Street Sewage Pumping Station Expansion

Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study Township of Centre Wellington

The Project

The Township of Centre Wellington has initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study for the required upgrades to the Union Street Sewage Pumping Station (SPS) to meet the demands of future development areas. This assessment will consider numerous SPS and/or collection system upgrade alternatives with the catchment area (refer to Study Area map) in order to identify the preferred location for a larger SPS with increased capacity. The Study Area for this assessment is shown below:



The Study Process

This Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study is being carried out in accordance with the requirements as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association's Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) document (March 2023). This study will be conducted in accordance with the requirements of a Schedule B study.

You are Invited to Participate

A key component of this Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study is consultation with the Indigenous Communities, the public, government agencies and interested stakeholders. A Public Information Centre will be hosted to share study information with the project stakeholders and to provide an opportunity to receive feedback on the study finding and recommendations. At the conclusion of the Study, a Final Environmental Study Report (ESR) will be developed and issued for review.
